Bostik Blu-Tack® is a permanently plastic, reusable multipurpose adhesive. Blu-Tack® is supplied in the form of rectangular strips between sheets of release paper, and packed in individual envelopes.

## USES

Blu-Tack® has a myriad of uses around the home, office, school, classroom, factory or workshop.

**Holds** up posters, cards, children's paintings, party decorations, maps, messages, etc. **Positions** telephones and calculators to desks, ornaments to shelves, photos in albums, screws to screwdrivers, model parts during painting, flowers and candles in place for table and flower arrangements, etc.

**Cleans** fluff from fabric and dirt from keyboards, model railway tracks, etc.

Use Blu Tack® Colour to create 3D **models** or fantastic murals on your window or wall.

For use on non-porous surfaces: vinyl coated wallpapers, painted surfaces, glass, and metal.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Read and understand the Safety Data Sheet before using this product. SDS can be acquired by visiting [www.bostik.com.au](http://www.bostik.com.au) or by scanning the relevant QR code on pack.

## SURFACE PREPARATION

1. Wash hands before use.
2. Ensure surfaces are clean; dry free from grease and loose materials.

## APPLICATION

3. For *non-laminated surfaces* make a 'blob' by tearing off a piece, pull and stretch into a ball and apply to one surface.
4. For *laminated surfaces* cut off 3-5cm pieces of Blu-Tack, remove the release paper on one side, apply to one surface, then remove the other release paper.
5. Using good thumb pressure, apply to the other surface.

## REMOVAL

To remove Blu-Tack, hold and twist off or roll it carefully off the surface. Any remaining shreds can be removed by rolling or dabbing a blob of Blu-Tack over the surfaces.

## STORAGE AND SHELF LIFE

Store away from heat, strong oxidizing agents and acids. Store between 5°C to 30°C. Shelf life is 5 years from the date of manufacture when stored as directed

Do not use Blu-Tack® Colour on absorbent, silk screen printed or hand stencilled wallpaper nor on porous brickwork.

The adhesive properties of Blu-Tack® increase over time, so take extra care when removing after a period of months.

On some surfaces after a long period of time Blu-Tack® can leave a slight oily mark but this can often be removed using De-Solv-It Sticky Spots, Stain Remover or lighter fluid. Before using these products, we recommend you test on a small inconspicuous area.

Not suitable to support heavy objects. 0.5g holds 105g of load.

Care should be taken on painted plaster as Blu-Tack® adhesive qualities may cause paint to come away from wall.
