



## DIY Valentine's Day Card

### You will need:

- 1 x Template printed onto white paper or card
- 1 x Sheet of coloured card (any colour)
- 1 x Blu Stick
- Scissors
- Coloured paints, pens or crayons
- Craft embellishments

1. Print the Valentine's card template onto white card or paper. You may want to have a couple spare in case of mistakes.

2. Colour in the Valentine's card template as desired using paints, crayons, Glitter Glue pens and similar.

We recommend painting activities to include: marbling, finger/potato painting, mirroring, making different strokes using a paintbrush, bubble or blow painting.

#### Tip

Using different techniques and a range of colours for your DIY Valentine's card will help to achieve a unique and colourful creation.

3. Carefully cut out the Valentine's card template along the bold black lines.

4. Fold the template along the dotted lines and then in half down the centre making sure that the coloured sections are on the outside.

5. Next, fold the coloured A4 sheet of card in half.

6. Apply Bostik Blu Stick along the folded flaps of the template illustrated with the 'glue here' text. Attach each flap to the inside of the folded coloured card (so the bottom point of the template is about a 1/3 of the way up from the bottom edge of the card).

7. Ta-da! You've created a DIY Valentine's Day card and it's time to write a message to your Valentine.

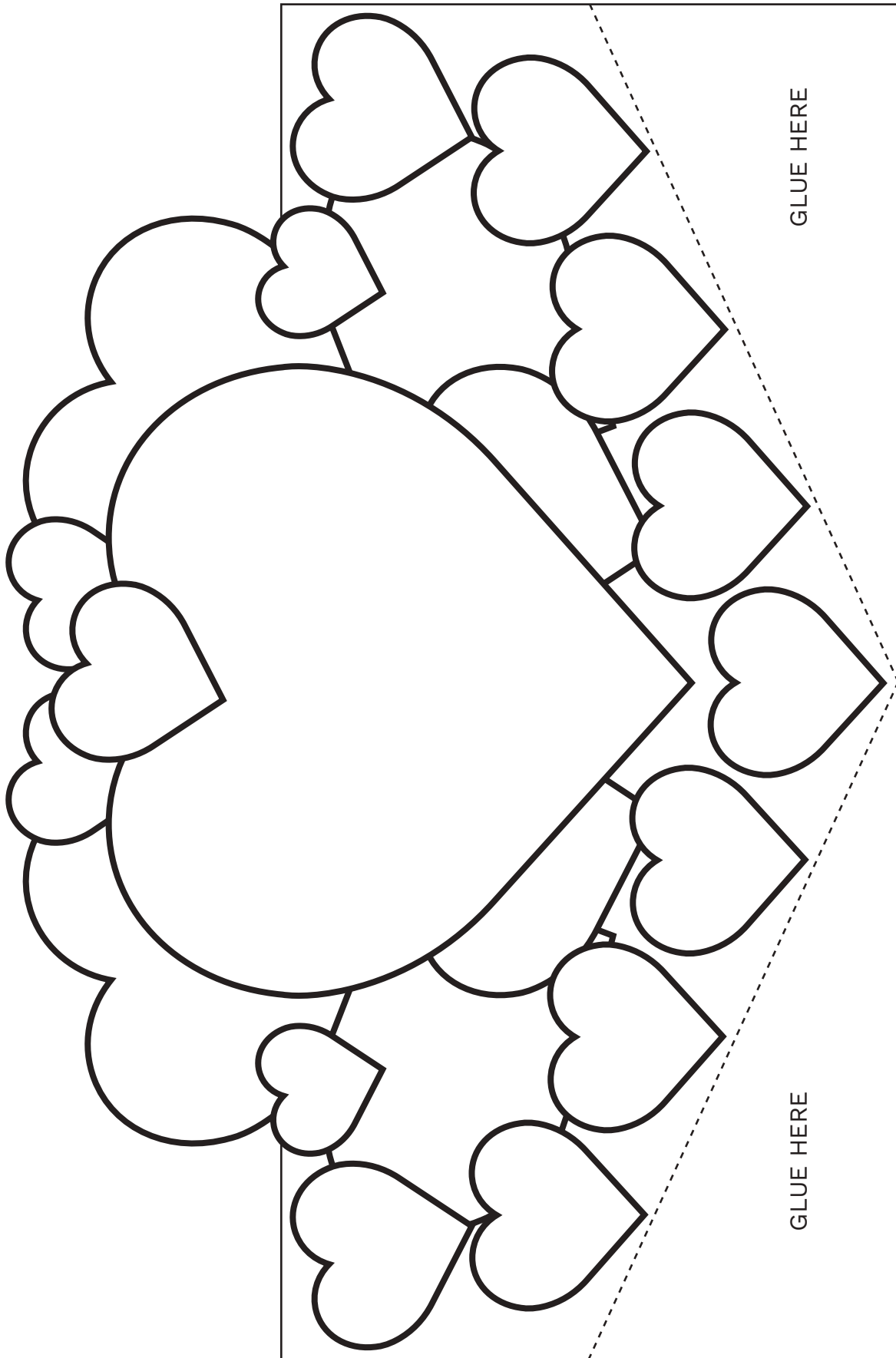
#### Tip
